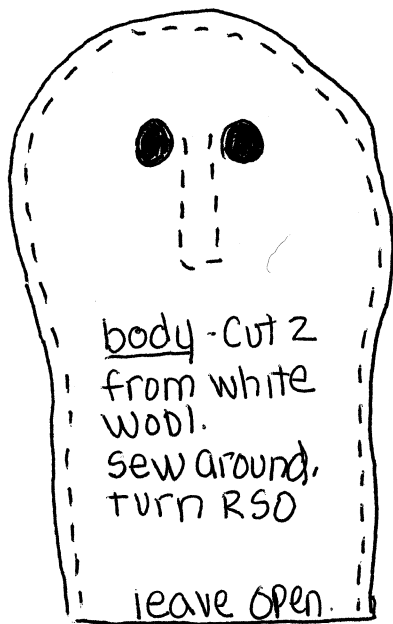

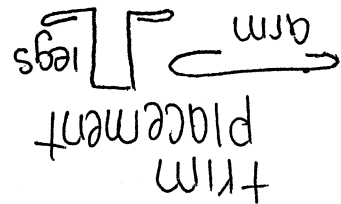

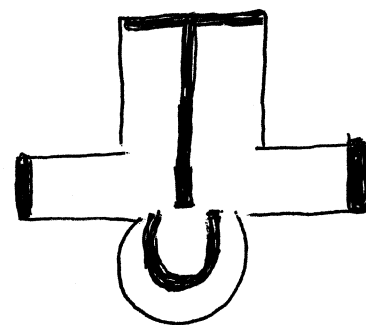
K-114 6 1/2" SANTA KIT



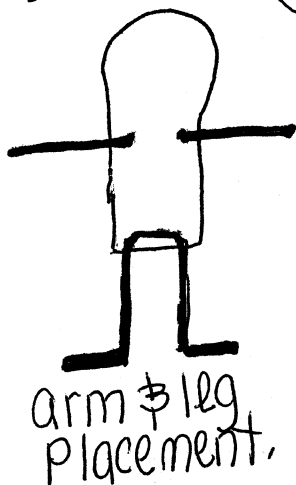
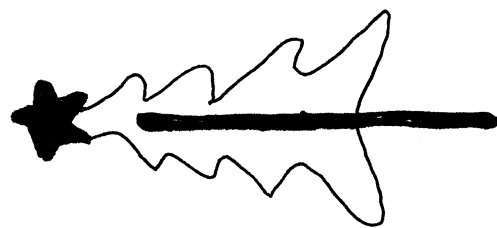
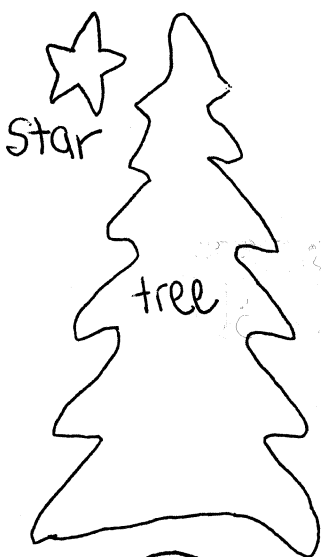
fold pipe cleaners:
arms & legs 1" at hands & feet
then wrap with floral tape



Cut 1/4" strips of white wool
for coat trim.
approx lengths:
cut 1 down front 1/4 x 4"
cut 1 around bottom 1/4 x 6 1/2"
cut 1 around face 1/4 x 4 1/2"
cut 2 arm cuffs 1/4 x 3"
hand sew trim to coat.
white thread (running
stitch)



cut 2 coats from red wool.
cut out face opening (coat front only)
Rst-sew underarm side seams. also shoulder and hat seams.
clip underarm. turn RSD.



Santa kit:

- Cut 2 bodies from white wool. Rst sew around. (Leave open at bottom.)
- Turn rso. Stuff body.
- Trace eyes onto steam a seam. Iron eyes to black wool. Cut out. Iron eyes to face. Stitch a pinched nose onto face.
- Fold both long pipe cleaners. Wrap tightly with floral tape. Paint black. Let dry. Also wrap small pipe cleaner. (do not fold in half) paint this tree stem with brown paint
- Fold legs as shown. Put legs into body and whip stitch body shut (securing legs into body)
- Make 2 small holes in back of body where shown. Put arms through back of body.
- Cut 1 coat. (Cut out face opening on coat front only. Rst-sew underarm, side seams. Shoulder and head seams. Turn rso)
- Cut strips of white wool for coat trim. Hand sew on to coat with white thread. (Down front, around bottom, around face and 2 arm cuffs.)
- Put coat on doll.
- Hot glue or tack stitch beard onto face.
- Trace 2 trees onto steam a seam (1 forward and 1 backwards), iron onto green wool. Cut out. Also trace 1 star onto steam a seam and iron onto gold fabric. Cut out.
- Put front and back of trees together with tree stem inside of trees. Put star on top of tree. Iron trees to secure. Tack stitch tree to dolls arms.
- Bend arms and legs as desired.
- Tea stain or tan dye as desired. Dry brush cheeks with red paint.
- Sew on pin back (for pin) or a string for an ornament
- Supplies needed: stuffing, brown, black, red paint. Pin back. Black and white thread, floral tape.
